Any application received after that date will be treated as late and your child may not be allocated a place in one of your preferred schools.

What we will be learning next week

Year 3

English: We will be retelling the story of Mini Rabbit on his adventure.

Maths: We will be learning about place value in 3-digit numbers. We will be making, drawing and writing 3-digit numbers.

History: We will be learning about the history of Ashfield Junior School.

Year 4

English: We will be continuing our unit on Arthur and the Golden rope and writing an extra scene in preparation for our graphic novel

Maths: We will be looking at magnitude and rounding 4 digit numbers.

Science: We are investigating sound and how we hear.

History: We are learning about Celtic hillforts and naming their different parts.

Year 5

English: We will be writing a range of descriptive complex sentences about mythical creatures. We will be learning about main and subordinate clauses.

Maths: We will be rounding 5 and 6 digit numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000 and 10000.

Geography: We will be learning about North America this half term. We have identified the 23 North American countries and we will now be finding out more about the different environmental regions across the continent

Year 6

English: Year 6 will continue to explore writing descriptive sentences using a range of sentence types including complex and compound

Maths: Year 6 will continue to explore place value in large numbers and begin to multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000.

Geography: We will create maps of biomes and where they are located on the Earth.

Science: We will explore the classification of plants.

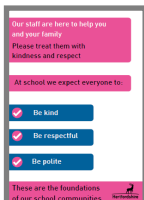
