Year 4 French Café



What we will be learning next week

Year 3

English: We will continue our local study of Bushey.

Maths: We will continue working on division. Practising at home by reversing times tables (eg I know that 24 divided by 3

is 8 as I know that 8 x 3 is 24) would be very helpful. **Science:** We will be exploring leaves in our plant topic.

Year 4

English: We are going to start planning our persuasive writing, advertising the chosen destination.

Maths: We will continue working on long and short division.

Geography: We will be looking at the Earth's structure and the diagram of a volcano.

Year 5

English: We are going to begin doing our reading and punctuation and grammar assessments.

Maths: We are going to be doing our arithmetic and 2 reasoning assessments.

History: We are going to be looking at Egyptian Gods and Goddesses

Vear 6

English: Mrs. Kothary's group will continue drafting and editing their non-chronological report, with a focus on formal language. Mr Hardy's Group will be continuing to write our reports on Sprites inspired by Spiderwick.

Maths: Mrs. Kothary's group will use their 2D shape knowledge to learn 3d shape properties. Mr Hardy's group will be continuing to explore a series of real life mathematical investigations.

RE: We will learn about the 4 Noble truths of Buddhism. **History:** We will be exploring the role of Women in WW2. **Geography:** We will be creating maps of the school grounds.
