## **Playground Equipment**


Just a polite reminder, please can you make sure that children do not use the playground equipment after school. This will ensure that no accidents and injuries occur.

#### What we will be learning next week

#### Year 3

English: We will be writing about Mini Rabbit's return journey after he has found the berries.

Maths: We will be comparing and ordering 3-digit numbers using the < and > signs. We will also think about estimating

and rounding.

**History:** We will be learning about how Ashfield has changed over time.

#### Year 4

English: We will be using the persuasive devices we have learned to write our own persuasive speeches!

Maths: We will be looking at counting in multiples of 3, 6 and 9

Art: We will be starting our Jabberwocky depictions

**RE:** We are thinking about how different religious festivals are similar to Eid.

#### Year 5

**English:** We will be writing a first draft of our monster non-chronological reports, focusing on using what we have learnt about multi-clause sentences and adverbials.

**Maths:** We will be rounding decimal numbers to one decimal place in maths this week.

**Geography:** We will be learning about the Grand Canyon in geography.

#### Year 6

English: We will complete our final setting description piece and start learning about slow motion writing techniques.

Maths: We will be exploring calculations and arithmetic strategies involving the 4 operations.

**RE**: We will explore the 4 Noble Truths in Buddhism.

**Art:** We will continue working on our final designs for our own cereal boxes. **Science:** We will be learning about organisms that are not plants or animals.
