What we will be learning next week

Year 3

English: We will be writing our own free verse poems using descriptive vocabulary and the different senses.

Maths: We will be finishing our work on mental addition, in particular securing the 'think 10' and 'think 100' strategies.

Science: We will be starting our new topic on Rocks.

Year 4

English: we will be looking further into explanation texts and using subordinating clauses to up-level our writing.

Maths: we will be completing our unit on factors.

Geography: we will be looking closely at the way the world is divided on a map.

Year 5

English: We will be writing setting descriptions that include fronted adverbials and figurative language. Our descriptions will be based on our new book, 'Cloud Tea Monkeys'.

Maths: We will be learning about common factors in maths this week.

Geography: We will be choosing and researching one of the main cities in North America. We will use what we learn to create an information leaflet.

Year 6

English: Mr Hardy's Group will continue to explore using repetition, inspired by Michael Morpurgo, in our writing. Mrs. Kothary's group will explore ways to create imagery in writing.

Maths: Mr Hardy's Group will be exploring factors and multiples. Mrs. Kothary's group will compare 6 and 7 digit numbers

Science: we will begin learning about Evolution and Adaptation following on from our trip to Whipsnade.

History: we will be learning how historians and archaeologists learnt about the Mayan Civilisation.
