What we will be learning next week

Year 3

English: We will begin writing a story based on 'Mini-Rabbit Not Lost'. **Maths:** We will be finding 10 or 100 more or less than a given number.

Music: We will be learning to play the Glockenspiels. **Science:** We will be continuing our unit on Light.

Year 4

English: We will create a map based on the story Arthur and the Golden rope. **Maths:** We will be talking about place value and learn about number magnitude.

History: We will start exploring the Iron Age in Britain.

Vear 5

English: We will be learning about the features of non-chronological reports and will be writing descriptive sentences based on our book about monsters.

Maths: We will be comparing and ordering 7-digit numbers.

Geography: We will be learning about the countries and some of the physical features of North America

Year 6

English: We will explore sentence structure through Michael Morpurgo's Kensuke's Kingdom. **Maths:** We will learn about multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000 in the Place Value topic.

Geography: We will continue to explore Biomes.

RE: We are going to learn about the 1st of the 5 Pillars of Islam.
