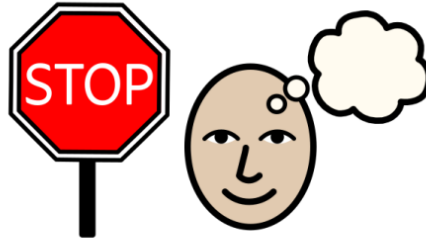

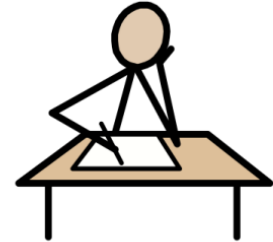

Reading

*Daily reading (to an adult where necessary) to build fluency, stamina and vocabulary. These reads should be sustained for at least 15 minutes each time and preferably read aloud.

*Reading is to be recorded twice a week on BoomReader with the number of pages read and a clear and well-written summary about what has happened in their book since their last summary. A summary should be no shorter than 5 descriptive sentences long.
