

Year 5 Enrichment Activities – Autumn Term

Find out more about one of the North American Countries we have learnt about. Think of an interesting way to present your findings.	Create your own monster! You can be as creative as you'd like in how you create it – draw, make, write, film, build, act, record.... 	Turn a book or story you have read into a comic or graphic novel.	Use objects around your house and/or garden to create your own font/typography/artwork. Try to stick to a theme e.g. use flowers to write the word 'flower'. 
Learn by heart the 13, 14 and 15 times tables.	Create a game to help you and others practise a maths concept e.g. coordinate battle ships.	Create a PowerPoint presentation showing what you learnt about in Science, History or Geography in Year 4 – like the water cycle, volcanoes, or Vikings	Create a 3D shapes poster to help you remember key facts. Could you also create nets that can be opened up and closed again to demonstrate their properties?
Can you find a creative way to help you remember the 23 countries of North America? Perhaps you could create your own 3D map that shows the countries, the oceans and the main mountain ranges. 	Choreograph a dance that can be taught to the class in our dance lessons. Create a step-by-step chart of the different steps and movements to help your classmates learn the dance.	Find out about Greek gods and goddesses (the Olympians) and create a class presentation, a poster, a booklet or a PowerPoint. 	Research and create a timeline of the Ancient Greek civilization. The timeline can be made in any way you choose.
