Reading

*Daily reading (to an adult where necessary) to build fluency, stamina and vocabulary. These reads should be sustained for at least 15 minutes each time and preferably read aloud. This does not include the 30 minute reading session on Mondays.

*Reading is to be recorded on Boom Reader with one entry being a well-written summary about what has happened in their book since their last read (a summary should be no shorter than 100 words or 10 short sentences long, and a second entry answering a pre-set question using the taught technique).

SATS

KS2 SATs are the statutory national curriculum tests taken at the end of Year 6 in England, assessing pupils' attainment in English Reading, Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS), and Mathematics. (gov.uk)
